Methods Help others

Preparation Time

Location Indoors

You will need:

- Pens
- Paper
- Computer/laptop and printer
- Digital camera
- Joke books
- Previous programmes to remind the beaver scouts of the activities they have done

Chinese Whisper

1. Sit the Colony in a circle and whisper a message to one Beaver Scout. Try and keep this short.
2. The Beaver Scout whispers the message to the person next to them in the circle who then whispers it to the next person and so on around the circle.
3. The Message will eventually get back to the first person. See if the message went around the circle without changing.
4. If you have Beaver Scouts who struggle with hearing, try a memory game – divide the colony into teams and line them up at one end of the hall. The first person in each team runs up and collects a short message either or by reading it from a leader or Keo. They run back to the team, pass the message on to the next person who runs up and passes the message to the leader or Keo.

Colony Newsletter

The Colony as a whole or in teams produces a newsletter of the activities they have done while in Beaver Scouts. This could include pictures and interviews. This could be passed to parents, and other members of the group.

Split the Colony into editorial teams and ask each team to work on different projects such as events, past meetings, silly stories, jokes, and photographs. Ask Keo and parents to be the editors for each team.
