Reminder of the Beaver Scout Promise

1. Ask the Beaver Scouts if they can remember their promise – check this by getting them to recite it to you.

1. Explain that, around the world, young people of their age meet, just like they do to enjoy different activities.

Beaver Scouts 6-7 years old

Promise

'I promise to do my best
To be kind and helpful
And to love God'



Hong Kong

Grasshopper Scouts 6-8 years old

Promise

'I promise to be a Grasshopper Scout, to love God,
to love people and to love my country.'



New Zealand

Kea Scouts 6-7 years old

Promise

'I will try to share my fun and help others'.

Saying hello in the language of those countries

As well as learning a little about Beaver Scouts in other countries, teach the Beaver Scouts how to say hello in the languages of those countries.



Netherlands

Dutch: 'Morgan'



United Kingdom

English: 'Hello'



Hong Kong

English: 'Hello'

Chinese: 'Ni Hao' (Nee HaOW)



New Zealand

English: 'Hello'

Game – North, South, East and West in French

1. Label each wall 'nord', 'sud', 'est' and 'ouest'
2. Call out each of the directions randomly and the Beaver Scouts have to run to the correct wall.
3. After the Beaver Scouts get used to this, make the last person to the wall say 'au revoir' before they sit out.

Boomerang

1. Copy the pattern onto cardboard and cut out.
2. Decorate it.
3. Place the boomerang on a book with one of the spokes sticking out and hit this with a pencil.
4. If it has been hit in the right way it will fly in a circle and come back to you.
